From Your Pastor *Engaging Culture*

Woe to those who call evil good, and good evil; who exchange darkness for light, and light for darkness; who exchange bitter for sweet, and sweet for bitter! Isaiah 5:20

On Wednesday evenings this summer we have been going through a series called "Engaging Culture". I cannot remember a time when the culture was changing so rapidly and the changes seem to go so clearly against the Word and will of God. Just this summer we have talked about the issue of transgender and sex changes after Bruce Jenner decided to become Caitlyn Jenner. Genesis 1:27 tells us that God created us as male and female and we not to celebrate those who take actions to alter our Creator's design.

In June the Supreme Court made a decision that basically redefined marriage. Homosexuals are not only allowed to marry but their rights are triumphing over the religious freedoms of Christians. We know that culture may take steps to redefine marriage but God's establishment of marriage has not changed and we must stand for Biblical heterosexual marriage that honors God.
