## From Your Pastor *A God Fearing Man*

I was having a conversation with Roger Walton this past Monday and he used the phrase "God fearing man" several times to describe his uncle that had recently passed away. In 1 Timothy 6 (verse 11), Paul refers to Timothy as a "man of God." While we don't hear that language often (only time we see it in the New Testament), we know what it implies. I knew Roger was referring to a man who lived his life under the authority of the Word of God and with reverence to God in words, actions, and deeds.

I got to thinking we need more "God fearing men" in the church, in our community, and in our country. We are all too familiar with smooth sounding politicians who promise one thing if elected and soon forget their promises after they are in office. For that matter, we are also familiar with men in the church (including pastors) who talk a good talk on Sunday and live for themselves during the week. We need some God-fearing men!

God-fearing men aren't perfect (only Jesus was perfect) but they strive to honor Christ in their lives. They seek to worship God through prayer, obedience, ministering to others, and gathering with God's people. They show kindness to others. They are willing to give when there is a need. They speak truth in love. They work hard to support their families and serve the Lord. Yes, we need more God-fearing men.

We have lots of good ministries at LBC and I praise the Lord for how He provides the laborers for those ministries. One area in which we struggle in is in our men's ministries. It is challenging to get men together for a meeting, for a Bible study, for a prayer breakfast, for most anything related to spiritual growth. We can't give up. Will you join me in praying that God will begin to raise up more and more God-fearing men at LBC?
