From Your Pastor *Unity*

*Make every effort to keep the unity of the Spirit
through the bond of peace. Ephesians 4:3*

We just finished going through 1 Timothy and I really feel like the Lord is going to use these instructions to make us into a healthier church body. We had some great discussion on Sunday night as we reviewed our study of 1 Timothy. I was particularly thankful for Paul's reminder in 1 Timothy 5 about treating older men as fathers, older women as mothers, younger men as brothers, and younger women as sisters. In other words, we are to relate to one another as family.

I think about all the conflicts that could have been prevented in churches if we treated each other like family. We would speak with greater patience, kindness and compassion. Treating each other like family would honor God because He calls us His children and I know the blessing it is when your children treat each other with love and respect.

God desires for His church to be unified and I am thankful for the unity I see at Lancaster Baptist. I don't want us to take our unity for granted. Jesus prayed this in **John 17:21** "*that they may all be one, just as You, Father, are in Me, and I in You, that they also may be in Us, so that the world may believe that You have sent Me.*" I think we often forget to pray for unity in the body (I do). If Jesus prayed for unity of His followers, we should be praying for unity as well. I especially want to see greater unity, respect, and interaction between our different generations. God can bring that about as we ask Him and work towards that end.

This Sunday we will start into 2 Timothy in a series I have entitled "Game Changers." I want us to look at 4 game changers that Paul mentions in his letter to Timothy. The first one is the gospel. Don't forget to pray for unity.
