Last week we were blessed with lots of opportunities to reach out in love to our community through LoveLoud. We had an awesome Sportsman's Expo with over 50 people indicating they wanted to make Jesus Lord of their lives. We were blessed with a powerful message and response on Sunday morning. I am so thankful for all who played a role in LoveLoud this year. As Paul reminds us in Galatians 6:9, "let us not grow weary in doing good, for in due season we will reap, if we do not give up."

This week we have the privilege of praying for various ministries in Kentucky that are working to spread the Gospel all around us. This month we will also be collecting the Eliza Broadus Offering.
