## From Your Pastor *Spreading the Word*

And the word of the Lord was spreading throughout the whole region. **Acts 13:49**

On Wednesday evening we are going through Acts and have began looking at Paul's first missionary journey and seeing the Gospel being spread amongst the Gentiles (non Jews). When Paul preached the Gospel in Acts 13 the people begged to hear more the following Sabbath (verse 42). Verse 44 tells us that "the next Sabbath almost the whole city gathered to hear the word of the Lord." I thought how awesome it would be for all of Lancaster to gather this Sunday to hear the word of God proclaimed.

While we can't expect everybody to gather to hear the Gospel, we are called to go make disciples and share the Gospel in our community. When the Gospel was proclaimed, many were saved (they rejoiced) and some (the Jews in particular) opposed the Gospel. We know there will be divided responses to the Gospel (some accept and others reject) but our charge is to go proclaim the good news and spread the word.

I have a prayer request regarding reaching the Hispanics in our community. We tried a few years ago to have services for Hispanics but we struggled because we didn't have a Hispanic Pastor that was able to stay connected with them. Let's pray that God might open a door and help us make some progress in providing a place and opportunity for the Gospel to be preached to our surrounding Hispanic neighbors. I talked to a man today who said he employed over 50 of them. I want to reach them with the Gospel. Let's ask the Lord to help us. Yes, we want the word of the Lord to spread throughout the whole region and many to be saved!
