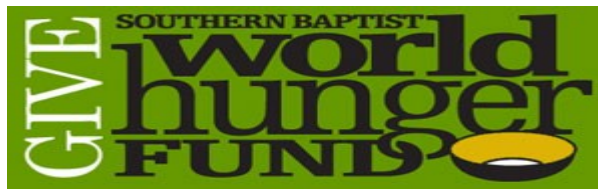

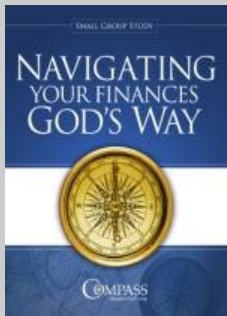
From Your Pastor

Fighting World Hunger



This Sunday is World Hunger Sunday. The need for hunger relief is huge (and growing). One out of every six people in the world is undernourished. One out of every six people in the U.S. don't get enough food to be healthy. Poverty among children is on the rise. 18.4 percent of Kentucky's children live in poverty. We live in an area where there are lots of hungry children. In November we will try to assist with food (Thanksgiving boxes) in Garrard County and in Eastern Kentucky. Our goal is to provide 100 turkeys (and fixins) to Eastern Kentucky and 150 in our community. We will have a meal to raise funds for this food on Sunday, Nov. 2nd. We will be delivering and handing out these turkeys/meals on Saturday, Nov. 22nd.

This Sunday whatever is given in our \$1 buckets (located at our exits) will go to the World Hunger Fund. The World Hunger Fund is having an eternal impact. In Kentucky alone, 192 people professed faith in Jesus Christ last year as a direct result of hunger relief ministries. We know Jesus had a heart for the poor, hungry, and hurting. We honor Him as we seek to feed the hungry and share the Gospel. May we give and pray for the hungry of our world. *Bro Harold*

MAKING DISCIPLES... (Questions kids ask)

Question: Why did Cain kill Abel?

Answer: ...not as Cain who was of the wicked one and murdered his brother. And why did he murder him? Because his works were evil and his brother's righteous (1 John 3:12).

We know that Cain killed Abel. If we look at the Bible account of Cain and Abel we see that they both offered sacrifices. But even though they both offered something to God, their hearts were different. See, Cain's heart was wicked and evil. God warned Cain that sin would be "at his door" or that sin had a desire for him. This is a reminder to us that sin in our lives is always trying to persuade us to do bad things that dishonor God. This is what happened to Cain. Cain's sacrifice would not have pleased God because of that – no matter what it had been. Now, Abel's heart was faithful and true to God and his sacrifice was excellent in God's eyes. When Cain realized that God was not pleased with his sacrifice but accepted Abel's, his heart became more wicked. He was angry and jealous of his brother and killed him out of envy. When I read the account of Cain and Abel, I see that God knows our hearts very well. We need to pray that our hearts are pure toward God and when we serve Him, we do it because of the sincere love, honor, and respect we have for Him – not like Cain. Then He will be pleased.
