## MAKING DISCIPLES...

**Question 3: How do we know there is a God?**

**Answer:** The light of nature in man, and the works of God, plainly declare that there is a God; but his word and Spirit only, do effectually reveal him unto us for salvation

**Scripture:** *Romans 1:18-20; Psalm 19:1-2; 2 Timothy 3:15, 1 Corinthians 1:21-24; 2:9-10; Matthew 11:27*

**Comment:** The question distinguishes two kinds of knowledge: one is natural and comes from conscience (“the light of nature in man”) and from the works of God in nature; the other is spiritual or saving, and comes from the recognition of the true value of God and the beauty of his character. Natural knowledge is possessed by all people and thus makes all people accountable to honor and thank God. Spiritual knowledge is possessed only by those whose natural blindness has been overcome by the Spirit of God (1 Corinthians 2:14-16).

Our children must come to see the difference between these lest they think they are saved by much natural knowledge about God—which
