At this 2016 Southern Baptist Convention, the North American Mission Board launched a compassion ministry called "Send Relief." To share Send Relief's mission of partnering with church to bring practical help with lasting hope to communities across North America, NAMB invited churches to share some of their community ministries and to apply for a Send Relief trailer. Immediately following the convention, I inquired about the steps to getting a trailer. They sent us an application and after discussing with the Mission team, we applied for a trailer. Last week we traveled to NAMB's headquarters in Alpharetta, Georgie and picked up one of the first trailers.

We look forward to using this trailer for community outreach activities, home repairs, and emergency responses. We were able to use it for the first time this past Monday evening as we had a cookout at Holladay Apartments in Danville where a number of Hispanic workers are staying. We had an awesome turnout on Monday evening and Bro. Ken was able to talk to many Spanish speaking men about the Lord and to invite them to our Hispanic Church.

This is a really nice trailer and we want to be good stewards of this gift from NAMB. We want to use it to reach out to and minister to our community. We will be working with the Mission Team and Men's Ministry to decide what type of equipment would be beneficial to have stored in this trailer so that we can do projects and be prepared to help when families have emergencies. We will be providing some list as to what you might be able to help us in furnishing for our trailer.

Additionally, we are praying about how God would have us utilize our church facilities (classroom in particular) in the future. Some have suggested an after school program, preschool, daycare, and other ministry ideas. We will meet on Sunday, Oct. 30<sup>th</sup> to discuss needs, ideas, and suggestions as to how we can best minister to our community. We welcome your prayerful input. May God give us a vision and may He get all the glory for whatever ministries He would have us attempt.
