HMP's Mission:

The purpose of the Health Ministry Partnership (HMP) is to promote health and wellness in the congregation and community.

The HMP seeks to serve the congregation and community through:

- Sharing information and resources,
- Referring people to needed services,
- Providing support.

HMP's Work and Priorities:

During the late summer of 2013, the HMP began work, focused on the health and wellness needs of older adults. The group met with a number of church members who were interviewed by committee members to discuss what people consider to be important needs, and to recommend possible next steps for the committee's work.

A number of people mentioned that transportation is a significant challenge for many, especially as people become older and more frail. Although the Senior Center provides transportation, many people may not know about those resources, and there are some limitations.

Isolation was mentioned as a concern, with many older adults living alone, and getting out less frequently. It might be helpful to investigate having some type of volunteer call reassurance, or people available to listen and provide information and referral.

People indicated that there are a lot of excellent resources in the region, including the Senior Center in Placitas, which has a wide range of services and activities. However, it can sometimes be difficult to access some health resources that are in Albuquerque, especially if those with health issues have limited transportation options.

The HMP discussed these issues, including the fact that many of us often do not know about many resources that do exist. The HMP decided to develop a Health Fair to share information and resources with LPPC members and community friends on March 2, 2014.

I. LOCAL RESOURCES

There are quite a few health care resources in Sandoval County and nearby Albuquerque. These include a range of services from health education, wellness and exercise programs to primary health care, home care and more intensive care found in nursing homes, rehabilitation centers and hospitals. A. Community Health Care and Mental Health Services

One can find primary health care through many private practice physicians and physician groups, other health care professionals, a Community Health Center such as El Pueblo in Bernalillo, and the Sandoval County Health Commons. B. Placitas Community Center – Our Local Senior Center

The Placitas Community Center provides a range of resources and services, including congregate and home delivered meals, transportation, blood pressure and other types of health screenings, enhanced fitness, aquatics and more. There are also a wide range of social activities and programs based on the interests of those involved with the center, including painting, yoga, beading, and work in clay. There are many prevention and wellness programs, including fall prevention, enhanced fitness and more. Medication management sessions are often available, where people come to have a health professional review medications and possible drug interactions (available locally or at other nearby centers).

C. Exercise, Wellness and Nutrition Resources

The Placitas community has a physical trainer and a Zumba Gold exercise program available at the office complex next to the Placitas Realty offices, next to the Homestead Shopping Center. Zumba is also at the Stardust Dance Studio in Bernalillo 135 N Camino del Pueblo, 3 days a week (Tues & Thurs, 6pm and Sat, 9am).

The Curves Fitness Center is located nearby in Bernalillo, at the Walgreen's Shopping Center at the corner of Highway 550 and Camino del Pueblo.

St Vincent de Paul Society in Bernalillo has a monthly Senior Wellness Clinic which meets the second Tuesday of each month at 8:30am at Our Lady of Sorrows Church, 301 Camino del Pueblo (http://olosbernalillonm.org/). It is staffed by RN volunteers and has been in existence for 12 years. They provide blood pressure checks, glucose monitoring, weight monitoring, and other services.

E. Supportive Services to Help People at Home

Older people and adults with disabilities in Placitas have a number of resources that can provide important supports that enable us to remain living at home, with a bit of assistance. Services can range from occasional in home help with chores and challenging tasks to daily home support for those who need more in-depth assistance. Help is provided by both non-medical and medical home care agencies. Most of these agencies are licensed, and it is recommended that one research options carefully and choose a licensed care provider. Medical home care is provided by a home care agency that is staffed by medical professionals and paraprofessionals, such as nurses, nurses' aides and trained home care workers. Non-medical home care agencies provide assistance through caregivers who are generally not licensed health care professionals (but who are trained); they provide more basic, non-medical assistance with activities such as cooking, bathing, dressing, and other tasks. These providers and others offer a range of in-home services billed directly to the patient. Some services may be covered through long term care or other insurance programs. Check to determine if any services might be eligible for third party billing.

Important Note: The State of New Mexico also provides <u>subsidized home-health care services</u> through a program called Personal Care Services (PCS). This program offers home-based care for disabled adults who qualify, paid through Medicaid. PCS allows people who need support with activities of daily living to hire a friend or non-spousal relative to help them, allowing people to remain at home with help. New Mexico has expanded its Medicaid coverage, and more people will qualify for care. Contact the NM Human Services Department at 866-251-4591, the State Call Center at 888-997-2583, or your Centennial Care Insurance Provider.

I. Benefits

New Mexico is expanding Medicaid coverage through Centennial Care, so more people are eligible for services. There is a deadline for enrollment. Contact the Centennial Care Call Center toll free at 888-997-2583, or call NM HSD at 888-997-2583. One may also contact the Sandoval County Community Services Department at 505-867-1396.

Older adults in Placitas can visit the Sandoval County Office on Aging or go to the website www.benefitscheckup.org for information about local, state and federal benefits to which one may be entitled.
