Parent's Pamphlet

The LPPC Christian Education Team is here to ensure that all children have a happy, positive Sunday School experience and know that God loves them.

<u>Curriculum</u> We use <u>We Believe</u>: God's Word for God's People published by the Presbyterian Church (USA). It is a Bible-based series which encourages participation and creativity. Planning is easy with more activities that we need. We try to keep the classes simple, interesting and fun. We love to decorate our classrooms with the children's art saving it for display in the Fellowship Hall in the summer.

<u>Sunday School begins</u> just after the "Gathering of the Children" in the 10:30 worship service. Children are escorted out by the teachers.

We first meet in the library area for a song and any announcements before breaking into two classes: Primary K-2nd and Intermediate 3rd grade and up.

On Communion Sundays the intermediate children will return to the service to receive communion and a blessing at the altar. Parents will pick up their Primary child to take them to Communion (some may choose to stay in the classroom). With the teacher's permission a class may return to Sunday School to finish an activity.

<u>Sunday School ends</u> when the worship service is over, lasting about 30-40 minutes.

Kindergarten and first graders should be picked up by their parents.

<u>Child Safety</u> is always a top priority. There will be two adults at all times in a classroom.

We use the golden rule, "Love One Another" as our classroom rule and try our best to guide children in a positive manner.

Background checks are required of all our teachers through the Presbytery of Santa Fe.

Discipline Policy: "Our goal is to have a happy, safe and fun learning environment for all of our Sunday School children. Every effort will be made to guide our children to appropriate behavior in the classroom. However, having tried all options, if behavior becomes a risk to the child or to other children, the parents will be notified. The child will be withdrawn for that class with the understanding that we will look forward to seeing that child again soon."
