

Stewardship at LPPC is a response to God's generosity. We give out of gratitude, knowing that God has enriched our lives with great abundance.

At LPPC the presence of Stewardship includes a monthly "Minute for Stewardship" at the beginning of the worship service and a pledge drive campaign during the month of October.

In 2013, 79/170, or 46% of LPPC members and friends have pledged a total of \$157,290. Of that total, \$149,882 is designated to the general operating fund. Special pledges have been given to Building for the Future (\$4,688), Casa Rosa (\$1,970), Memorial Garden (\$700), and to our relationship with Presbyterian churches in Cuba (\$50 and a matching gift of up to \$1,500).

The Stewardship campaign for 2014 is being conducted October 6th through November 3rd. Our theme is "Let's Hit It Out of the Park," using a baseball motif. **Our goal this year is 100% of the congregation pledging to the work and worship of our church.** We opened our campaign with a luncheon after the 10:30 worship service that featured baseball fare—hot dogs, salad, chips and Baby Ruth candy bars. Each Sunday in October at the beginning of the service a Minute for Stewardship is featuring a short event to remind the congregation of our gratitude for God's generosity in our lives. We will celebrate our pledge drive on Nov. 3rd with cake and ice cream.

Members and friends can complete their 2014 pledges by sending in their pledge forms to the church office with 'ATTN: Stewardship' on the envelope, or by placing their pledge form in the offering plate on Sunday morning.
