The return to Peru after our visit to the states was good and we hit the ground running with the first project on the list being getting the Junglemaster mission house to a more completed stage. Many of our brothers and sisters in Christ are now beginning to use the house as a stopping point as they travel through on their way into and out of Iquitos. It has also been used as a jumping off point for a few American missionaries as they travel upriver. And, many of the local pastors like to stop in and talk, pray with us, or sing some worship songs. This has been our hope and prayer for this house. Because of the support you have given; it has become a place for many to see God's love and grace.

Another project that has started to develop is sending the pastors and leaders that Junglemaster Ministries has been working with to a seminary school here in Nauta. This seminary school has been specifically formed to work with village pastors and leaders. Currently we have 1 pastor and 2 leaders from up river taking classes and will start 4 more next year. They are excited and have told me that they have been praying to receive more continual biblical training and this opportunity is a great answer to prayer. Praise God. Through the years you all have supported Junglemaster's mission to train the local leaders and with your continued support we can provide more extensive training for these pastors.

As most of you know almost as soon as we moved here a bar opened up across the street and this meant extremely loud music, fighting on the sidewalk in front of our house, and yes, sometimes even vomiting, and it usually wouldn't stop until early morning. Well, after lots of prayers; Junglemaster is actually renting this building and currently Amy and Carmen are turning it into a youth center. Our purpose is to reach the youth in Nauta, and that God will raise up young local missionaries. The name of the bar was Oasis so we decided to stick with the name and call it the Oasis Youth Center or OYC for short.

In other news...

Our family is still adjusting to life here in Peru. I'd be lying if I said it was easy; but, God is ever faithful and His word and love helps us everyday. Amy was asked to speak at a family enrichment class and was able to share some of God's design for motherhood and families. Carmen is settling in to life and making friends. She has started to play soccer and is enjoying the experience. We are looking forward to having our family, Wes, Toni, and Gilli, come for Christmas!
