Boiler Blues Continue

While we are enjoying the results of the costly repair of the main boiler that heats the Sanctuary, Multi Purpose Room, Choir Room, Rotunda, Narthex, and Church Offices, the north boiler (which heats the IHN Wing and Fellowship

Hall) **froze** earlier this week, causing water in the pipes to put enough pressure on some of the gaskets that they blew. This necessitated extra time for our new custodian to close off the water break and mop up the flood. The repairman later replaced the damaged piping (see **pink** oval above) and has attempted to contain some of the heat in the north boiler room to avoid further freezing in these recent arctic temperatures.

Generous folks have already donated \$3,650 toward repair of our other boiler's bills of over \$10,000—and we have filed for reimbursement of these damages with our insurance company—but the repair bills are coming due. Please prayerfully consider writing a separate check to offset the cost of these *unbudgeted* expenses, and indicate it is for the "boiler" in the memo. Every little bit helps! Thank you.
