Alyce Marie Mantel (left) passed away Tuesday, July 29, at the age of 85. Alyce and her late husband, Jim Mantel, joined LBC in 1972 and had been married 58 years at the time of his death in 2012. Jim's firm, Mantel & Teter Architects, was the

design architect of LBC's Preschool/PDO addition and the Parlor/Hearth Room additions in the mid-1980s.

Alyce's Visitation occurred on Thursday, July 31, from 5:00-7:00 p.m. in the Sanctuary, followed by a Funeral Service at 7:00 p.m. Rev. Larry J. Winter officiated. Burial occurred at 10:00 a.m. on Friday, Aug. 1, at Leavenworth National Cemetery. A Memorial Fund has been established in her name.
