Kids ask so many questions. Some of the questions they ask are easy to answer, some are cute, some are down right annoying, and if we're honest sometimes kids ask questions that we don't have the answer to. We all face times in life that we don't have the answer. How do we handle when we don't have the answer as an employee? How about when someone asks you a deep question regarding your faith, and you are not sure how to answer as a Christian? Life can blindside us with problems, sickness, challenges that we never saw coming. What can we do when we are out of answers?

Daniel in the Bible was often faced with questions that under ordinary circumstances he could not answer. However, we see that Daniel recognized that he was an ordinary man who had a relationship with the "Extra Ordinary God." Daniel is able to interpret dreams and continuously provides wise counsel to the king. Even in times of great duress Daniel acts with poise and confidence.

Today, if you are facing a situation where you are out of solutions we can learn from Daniel's example.

1st Recognize you are an ordinary person. Do everything you can, but don't 'beat yourself up' over what you can't do.

2nd Rely on the Extra Ordinary God that you serve in prayer.

3rd Respond in an unexpected fashion by acting upon the will of God for your circumstance.
