Lighthouse Kids

Who can participate in the Kids Worship service?

Our services are designed for kids three years of age (potty trained) through fifth grade. For your child to enjoy the service as intended, we ask that any child sick or having a fever in the last 24 hours stay at home to get well.

When are the kid worship services?

Kid worship services run concurrently with our two adult worship services on Sundays at 9:30a & 11:00a.

What is your check-in process?

When you enter the check-in area. It is here that students will receive their nametags. First time guests will need a parent to fill out a "Child Info Card" before they will receive a nametag and a first time guest bag.

What does a kid worship service look like?

Our kids are encouraged to connect to God through praise songs, prayer, offering, and Bible teaching. Our 3rd through 5th grade students come, as a class, to the adult worship service to participate in praise songs and prayer. Just before Pastor Keith begins his message, our students leave for their own classroom in the kid's area where they take an offering and participate in their own Bible lesson. Our pre-school through 2nd grade students have their own time of praise songs, prayer, and offering in the kids area. The simple songs are great for teaching truths about God and working out energy! These students break into smaller groups (3 year olds, 4 year olds, & Kindergarten-2nd grade) for their Bible Lesson.

What do kids learn in their worship service?

Our kids follow Group Publishing's "Kid Own Worship" curriculum. This curriculum covers the main Bible stories and themes through a three year scope and sequence. The story and theme your child is learning in a particular service is always published on a large sign in our kids' area and on the back of the weekly bulletin.

What is our AWANA kid's club?

AWANA is our kids' growth group program for pre-school through 5th grade students. Students are divided into different "clubs" based on their age/grade. Pre-school students are in the "cubbie" club, kindergarten through second grade students are in the "sparks" club, and third through fifth grade students are in the "Truth and Training" also known as "T&T" club. In these clubs our students learn Bible memory verses, play games, and participate in a Bible lesson time which can also include crafts/activities, music, prayer, and more!

Why is there a registration fee for your AWANA program?

The AWANA program is very comprehensive in that it includes individual handbooks, many different awards, uniforms, and many other resources. The cost for registration is \$25 for one child, \$40 for two children, and \$60 for three or more children. There are limited scholarships available for families who may not be able to participate otherwise.
