**Our Verse:** Matthew 6:6 But when you pray, go into your room, close the door and pray to your Father, who is unseen. Then your Father, who sees what is done in secret, will reward you.

**Math:** We will use manipulatives, calculations, and logical reasoning to complete our math investigations. All students will conclude their chapter studies. Then we will reinforce our skills taught this year as well as participate in whole class activities centered around finding the mean, median, and mode of probability experiments.

**Reading:** Our reading skills will focus on grade level vocabulary, using context clues to define unfamiliar words, and identifying the structure of events in a story. We will focus on fluency by using fluency phrases (three words that flow together) on our grade level. We will work on identifying nonfiction text structures such as cause and effect, description, problem and solution, sequence, and compare and contrast as we read out texts and novels.

**Spelling: We are working on lesson 27.**

**Writing:** We are revising our writing with a focus on sentence structure, organization, and word choice. A narrative writing selection is now underway. Our narrative pieces are almost ready for revising and editing. We will explore syllabication and practice dividing words properly, identify linking and helping verbs, and paraphrasing. We are busy writers in Room 17.

**Science:** We will conclude our lesson on ecology with a look at food chains this week with a look at habitats, predator, and prey.

**Social Studies:** We will conclude our law making studies.
