1. unique: Something is unique if it is the only one of its kind.
2. infest: If insects or animals infest a place, they are there in large numbers and usually cause damage.
3. intervals: Something that happens at regular intervals is repeated over and over with a certain amount of time in between.
4. delicate: If something is done in a delicate way, it is done with great care so that nothing is broken or hurt.
5. flexible: Something is flexible if it can bend or be bent easily.
6. bond: A bond is a feeling or interest that unites two or more people or groups.
7. inspires: If something inspires you, it makes you excited about doing something good.
8. preserve: To preserve something is to keep it from being harmed or changed.
