Little Swatara Church of the Brethren Pavilion RULES AND POLICIES – Revised September 2013

- *The Pavilion is open the first Saturday in May and closed the last Saturday in October.
- *Members may use the Pavilion Facilities free of charge, however donations are always appreciated.
- * <u>Donations</u> are accepted by Non-Profit organizations such as:
 - 50 Plus, Farm Women, WCTU, 4-H, Scouts, etc.
- *Non-members may use the Pavilion for a fee of \$150 and a Facility Use Form needs to be completed.
- *The church secretary is in charge of reservations and keys to the pavilion.

*Guidelines when using the Pavilion:

- 1. ABSOLUTELY NO SMOKING permitted on Church grounds!
- 2. ABSOLUTELY NO ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES permitted on Church grounds.
- 3. ABSOLUTELY NO PETS on Church property or Church buildings.
- 4. Dancing is permitted in the pavilion. Those engaging in dancing in the pavilion are asked to remember it is a church related facility, and that, therefore, they should avoid any inappropriate behaviors or music. (Council Meeting Min, May, 2002)
- 5. Groups are welcome to use the Pavilion Kitchen appliances. Please follow these procedures:
 - a. Groups may use utensils and equipment in kitchen drawers.
 - 1. Clean and dry all items after use.
 - 2. Return item to proper drawers.
 - b. Groups must supply their own paper products, staples and food.
 - 1. "Staples"ie- salt, pepper, sugar, flour, butter, ketchup, dish towels, and detergent.
 - 2. Left-over food must be taken home, not refrigerated.
- 6. Remove all trash from containers and put in dumpster behind church prior to leaving pavilion. Clean out containers if dirty.

Please Note:

- a. Church will provide liners for trash containers.
- b. Put new liner in all cans prior to leaving pavilion
- c. Floors must be swept.
- d. Chairs and tables must be placed on racks unless otherwise notified.
- 7. Make sure all appliances and lights are turned off before departing.
- 8. Little Swatara Church of the Brethren IS NOT RESPONSIBLE for accidents that may occur.
- 9. Privileges of later use may be rejected if guidelines are not adhered to by party involved.

 - 1. clean up afterwards
 - 2. return items to proper place

 - 1. "Staples" include- salt, pepper, sugar, flour, butter, ketchup, dish towels, and detergent.
 - 2. Left-over food must be taken home, not refrigerated.
- 6. Remove all trash and put in dumpster behind church prior to leaving pavilion. Clean out trash containers if dirty.

- b. Put new liner in all cans prior to leaving pavilion
- c. Sweep floors.
- d. Chairs and tables must be placed on racks unless otherwise notified.
