

Yesu Akwagala Bible College in Seguku, Uganda was founded by the World Outreach Ministry Foundation. They offer a full four year Bachelor of Theology Degree in affiliation with Seattle Bible College. With a focus on training African nationals for vocational ministry, they draw students from throughout Africa, including the countries of Uganda, Sudan and Ghana. Many of their students have planted churches even before they have graduated from college. Currently the college is co-directed by Pastor Dennis Traverse and Rob Guthrie who both have long term affiliation with Living Faith Bible College (LFBC).

The Ugandan Experience

Living Faith Bible College (LFBC) is partnering with Yesu Akwagala Bible College (YABC) in Seguku, Uganda to offer an exciting intercultural opportunity for Canadian and U.S. students. During the fall semester of their second year of studies at LFBC students will have the option to spend 11 weeks in Uganda. While there, they will take courses at YABC and participate in ministry alongside African students. In addition, students will have many opportunities to experience Ugandan culture and the beauty of the African landscape. Course credits received at YABC are transferrable back to LFBC so students can enjoy an extended intercultural experience without sacrificing their studies in Canada.

Accommodations

Students will stay in the mission guest house which can easily accommodate up to 20 students. Since rooms have private bathrooms, the guesthouse can accommodate both men and women. While in the guest house all meals will be provided; however for the purpose of building relationships, students will eat the noon meal during the school week with the African students in the college cafeteria.

Cost

Room and board in Africa will be similar to costs at LFBC. However, the greatly reduced tuition will help offset the cost of flights to and from Africa. Including flights and all vaccination shots, the estimated additional cost for each student will likely run from \$1,000 to \$1,500 on top of normal LFBC costs for a total of \$11,000 to \$11,500 for the entire college year.
