RELATIONAL DISCIPLESHIP

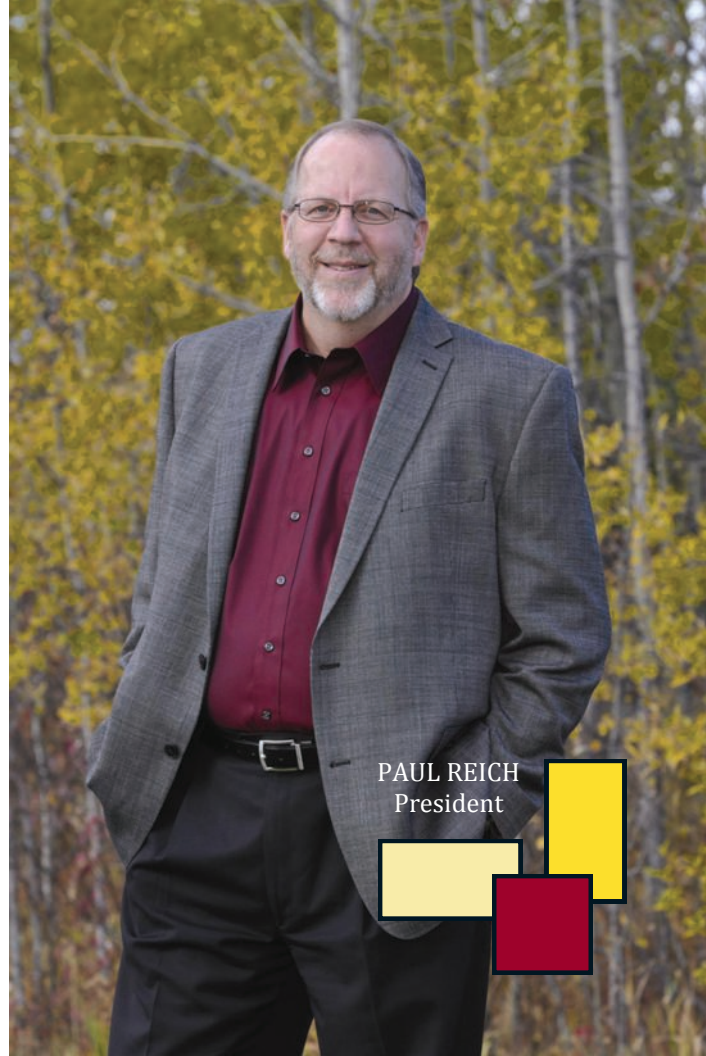

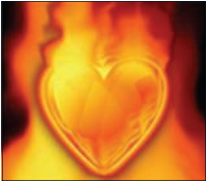


LFBC is committed to providing sound biblical, theological and practical ministry-oriented education from a Charismatic/Pentecostal perspective within the historic evangelical tradition. To ensure holistic and well-rounded training for our students all of our courses and programs are structured on a head, heart, hands, and feet model.



HEAD = truth (wisdom)

One of the important practices for spiritual transformation is renewing the mind (Romans 12:1-2; Ephesians 4:23). Our courses and programs are carefully sequenced to help students grow in their knowledge and understanding of God's Word and gain insight for Christian living and service.



HEART = character & passion (worship)

Jesus taught that the heart is the center of life. Our aim is to help students become passionate for God with a desire to please Him in all they do. Our courses and program components challenge students at the heart level and emphasize the "abiding life" (John 15) to help them develop the fruit of Christ-like character.



HANDS = skills (works)

Each believer is given spiritual gifts and has an important role to play in Christ's body and in the world. We are all called in some fashion to Christian service. At Living Faith we equip students with a wide range of practical skills for both lay and vocational ministry.



HEELS = lifestyle (walk)

Christianity is more than a belief system; it is a lifestyle. The Bible calls us to "walk in manner worthy of the Lord" (Colossians 1:10; Ephesians 4:1). Integrated throughout our courses are principles and skills that help students put feet to their faith and experience success in life, marriage, and community.



LFBC's **BLOCK SYSTEM** OFFERS FOCUS ... FLEXIBILITY ... FREEDOM

Living Faith Bible College divides each semester into five course blocks allowing students to complete an entire course every three weeks. This system has a number of distinct advantages over the semester system and provides the following benefits:

FOCUS

Students can concentrate on one topic at a time and not have conflicts with other classes and assignments.

FLEXIBILITY

The block system provides opportunity for offering specialty courses taught by qualified adjunct faculty from throughout Canada, the U.S.A. and abroad. Its scheduling flexibility also allows for extended off-campus ministry experiences between blocks.

FREEDOM

Since there are no conflicts with other courses, the block system allows off-campus learning experiences such as field trips, outdoor education, a trip to the Holy Land, or a mission trip. It also allows part-time and audit students to schedule time off work to attend select course blocks.

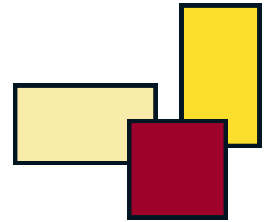

DORMITORIES

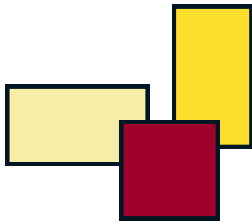
Single students are housed in three dorms that comfortably house two students per room. Each room is furnished with beds, desks, dressers, closets, and shelves.

FAMILY HOUSING

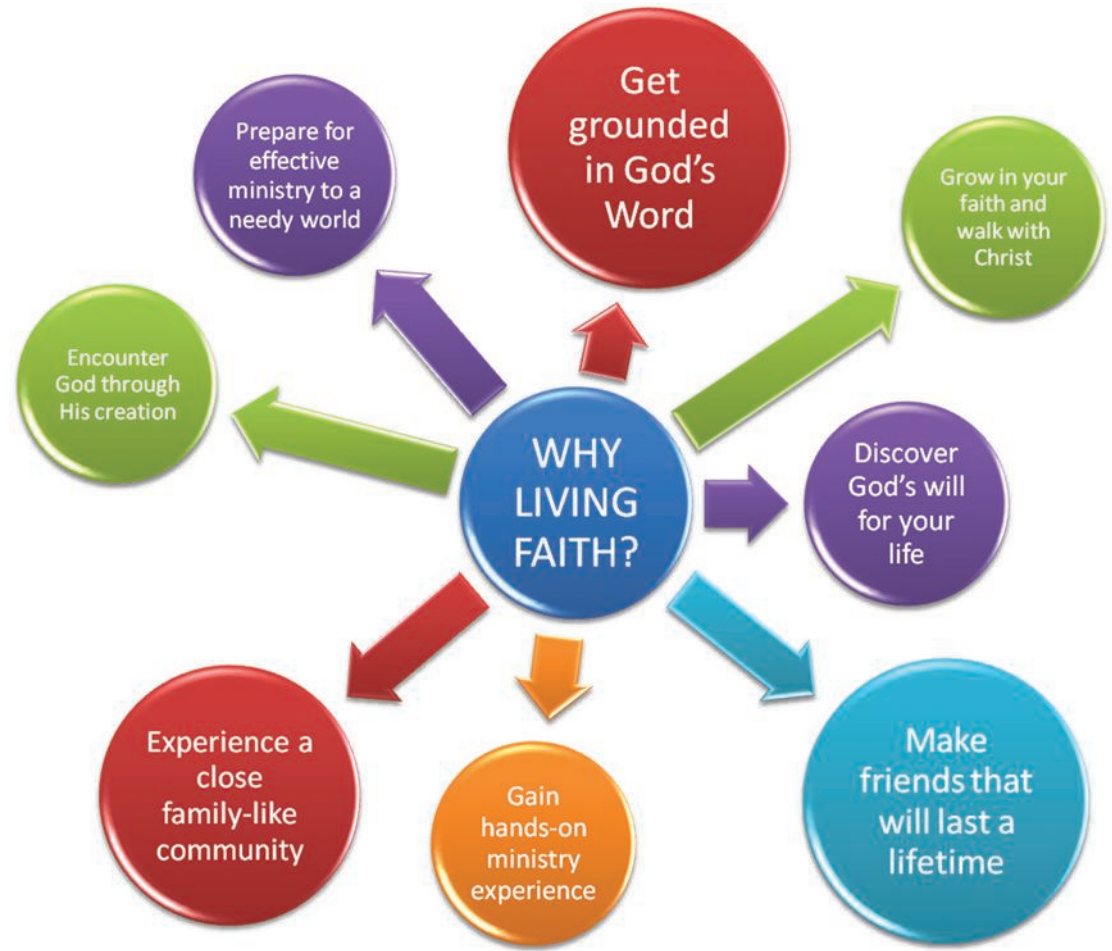
A limited number of mobile homes or small cabins are available for student families. Families may also apply to move their own mobile onto campus.

HOW TO APPLY

COMPLETE APPLICATION

Accurately complete all sections of the application form (available at www.lfbc.net). Include a separately typed personal testimony. Your testimony should contain the following elements:

- BC-Before Christ: Include aspects of your life before coming to Christ.
- RC-Receive Christ: Share the events leading up to and including your commitment to Christ.
- AC-After Christ: Include highlights of your walk with Christ.
- Transparency: Be open and honest.
- Typewritten: Double-spaced and 750 to 1,000 words in length.

INCLUDE ENCLOSURES

Be sure to include the following when you mail your application:

- \$25 Application Fee (non-refundable)
- A Recent Photo
- Your Testimony

REQUEST REFERENCES

Ask qualified references of your choice to complete and return the character reference forms (available at www.lfbc.net).

Pastoral Reference

Give this form to your pastor, youth pastor, elder, deacon or spiritual mentor. This reference must be at least 21 years of age, unrelated, and must have had an active relationship with you for at least one year.

Personal Reference

The reference completing this form must be 21 years of age, unrelated, and must have known you for at least one year. This reference should have a good knowledge of your walk with Christ, and be able to answer questions regarding your faith.

SEND TRANSCRIPTS

Contact your high school (and any post-secondary schools you have attended) and request that an official copy of your transcripts be mailed directly to Living Faith. Students may send unofficial copies of transcripts to expedite the admissions process while we wait for the official transcripts to arrive. Homeschoolers are evaluated on an individual basis. Please contact the office.

APPLY FOR HOUSING

Married students, families, and mature students wishing to obtain residence outside of the dorms, must complete a housing request form to be eligible for renting private residences or moving a mobile on to campus. To obtain this form, contact the office. All single students must live in the dorms unless alternate housing arrangements are approved.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

U.S. Students:

Canada currently requires both a valid passport and student visa in order to study at LFBC. To get a student visa (Canadian Immigration Form 1208) you must present the following information at a Port of Entry (border crossing station or airport) when entering Canada:

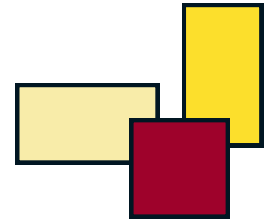
- Your letter of acceptance from the college
- Your passport
- Proof of sufficient funds (e.g. a certified cheque, a bank statement, or official letter from your sponsor)
