The core commitments at LOL (for all 3+ years):

- 1. Active participation in KIC and active engagement in Small Groups. Regular attendance is expected (80%). Your engagement should be more than just a physical presence. Deep and active participation is a vital part of the Confirmation process. Bring your own life experience to the small group discussions! Students may have no more than 5 absences. If one exceeds five missed classes, there will be a one-on-one meeting with Pastor Amy to discuss a makeup (aka homework) assignment.
- 2. **Worship Worksheets.** Students are responsible for the satisfactory completion of **ten (10) worship worksheets** during each program year.
- 3. **Service.** Students are expected to do 10 hours of community service each year. Students and parents complete a Service Worksheet, for tracking purposes. Ideally, at least 5 of these hours should be served at Lord of Life sponsored events. Some LOL opportunities include: Trunk or Treat, assisting with Sunday School or Vacation Bible School, participating with sponsored Kids Against Hunger or Feed My Starving Children events, serving with hospitality team on Sunday mornings (ushering, greeting, etc), assisting with worship (reading the Scripture lessons, singing in worship, etc).
- 4. **Event Participation.** Students must participate in the following scheduled events:

a. Confirmation Orientation Sept 2016

b. Weekly Competition mid Oct-mid Nov 2016
 c. Lenten worship services (sit in small groups) March-April 2017
 d. Lenten Dinner prep/cleanup and serving (once per year) March-April 2017
 e. Guide Group fellowship or service activities Nov 16, Feb 1, April 19

f. Large Group service project DATE TBD

- 5. **Retreats and Mission Trips.** In the fall of 10th grade, there will be a Pre-Confirmation Rite Retreat (off-site, overnight). Attendance at this retreat is required. In addition, multi-age retreats, youth gatherings, or mission trips may be offered. Students are encouraged to participate with as many as possible as these experiences can be very impactful in one's faith exploration.
- 6. **Camp.** Students should attend at least ONE weeklong camp during their 6th, 7th, 8th, or 9th grade years. Camp opportunities will be announced as available.

- 1. All previous noted commitments for all years, plus
- 2. Faith Statement, and
- 3. Interview (at mandatory Pre-Confirmation Retreat), and
- 4. Confirmation Sunday (See additional document for explanation of final year requirements)
