Communion Instructions for Lent: Communion will be served by intinction each Sunday during Lent. The bread we are using is gluten free, so everyone will be able to participate from the same loaf. After the Pastor has consecrated the bread and juice, he will take the communion and serve the assisting Elders, and then he will give the elements to the Elders who will create two stations at the front of the sanctuary. The Deacons will then begin to guide the congregation forward, starting at the back of the sanctuary with the pews on the window sides of the aisle. Those sitting on each window side will come forward as the Deacons instruct and return to their seats in the same aisle. When everyone on the window side has been served, the Deacons will begin guiding those seated in the center pews to come forward in the same way, beginning again from the back of the sanctuary. For anyone who has difficulty coming forward, you may remain in your seat, and an Elder will come to you with the communion elements. If you do not wish to dip your bread in the cup, you may take an individual cup from the altar table.
