The Names of God "Hallowed Be Your Name" #3

Yahweh Text: Exodus Chapters 3, 6

Elohim is the c_____ of everything that exists.

The word Yahweh came from the Hebrew word "to be." God said: I AM That's my name Yahweh.

But Yahweh is God's personal name, and it was the special property of His covenant people.

Hallelujah, Halle-(Praise) Jah (Short for Yahweh). Hallelujah is praising I AM.

God has a personal name, and the reason he lets you have that name is simple, God wants you to realize that God desires a personal relationship with his children.

As a general rule in the Old Testament, Elohim is used in God's relationship with nature or creation. But Yahweh is used when God deals with his children. He deals with His children by His personal name.

Non-believers can only know Him as Elohim. But to those who seek Him personally, He gives them the right to call Him Yahweh.

God wants to give His personal name to you. Ref: Numbers 6:22-27

God wants to put His personal name on you and wants to bless you with wisdom and power. So what does Yahweh mean to us?

#1 Yahweh is our u_____ self-e_____ God. When Yahweh said I AM, He was saying that he possesses in Himself essential life and permanent existence. Yahweh doesn't have an ending and exists in a dimension where time is irrelevant.

Yahweh has life in Him. Yahweh has the "power of being," the power behind all existence. Any life that has ever lived or will ever live derives its existence from Yahweh. Ref: Isaiah 26:4; Psalm 90;2

We cannot grasp existence outside of time and space, but there are two things we can do with regard to Yahweh, the uncaused, self-existent God.

A. We can recognize God's e_____.

The Bible says we can't completely understand the "eternality of God, but we at least can recognize it. Ref: Romans 1:20

B. The Second Thing The Bible Says—Is We can Take C_____ In It

Why? Because: What God is now---He always has been, and He will always be Ref: Hebrews 1:8; Isaiah 51:6; Jeremiah 31:3; Isaiah 26:3, 4; Proverbs 18:10

In fact have you ever wondered how we could be forever in heaven and not get bored? I'll tell you why.

Because when we get to Heaven we are going to worship an eternal God, which means we will always find something new, about our God and we will praise Him.

#2 Yahweh Is our U_____, P_____ Keeping God.

Yahweh stresses God's absolute faithfulness to His Word and Yahweh hasn't changed. He is a covenant promise keeping God who is faithful to Abraham's seed, and we as Christians are grafted into Abraham's seed by the blood of Jesus

Yahweh is a God that does not change, even when we do. Ref: 2nd Timothy 2:13

When I AM makes you a promise, and you go ahead and claim it, as your possession because I Am can be nothing else than who He is. He is the God who remembers His promises and keeps every one of them.

Yahweh is the same yesterday, and today, and forever. He is the unchanging promise keeping God.
