Text: Luke 2:8-20

Verse 10 -- And the angel said unto them, Fear not: for, behold, I bring you good tidings of great joy, which shall be to all people.

Verse 11-- For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Savior, which is Christ the Lord...

Verse 13 -- And suddenly there was with the angel a multitude of the heavenly host praising God, and saying,

Verse 14 -- Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace, good will toward men.

1. Jesus came for people.

2. Jesus came for theof peace
God's ideal is that we live together in peace and goodwill with one another. Ref: Rom. 14:19, 1st Cor. 14:33
Our God is not a God of conflict, or a God of confrontation, or a God of war. He wants his people — all people — to live together in peace. That's why Jesus came. Ref: Colossians 3:15
God has called us to peace. When we dedicate our lives to turmoil and conflict, we miss out on his calling.
3. Let's glorify God by being peace with one another.
We glorify God when we live together in peace. Ref: Psalm 133:1
