

We want to thank those of you who gave to our Lenten collection for the Church Women United Thrift Shop and for our local missionaries, who are involved in World Partners. The Church Women United Thrift Shop began as one woman's concern for local migrant workers and has grown to over thirty years of helping those in need in the greater Toledo area. Not only does this mission provide groceries, but also emergency clothing, household items, eyeglasses, orthopedic shoes, prescriptions, etc. for those in need. We feel honored to be able to help them in their mission.



We also have two representatives from World Partners, who must remain anonymous. They are a part of the division of World Partners which is called Immigrant Ministries and they work with Arabic families in this area. World Partners serves in twenty-three countries by engaging in worldwide evangelism, discipleship, and service to God's glory.

Hebrews 11:1 (ESV)

Now faith is the assurance of things hoped for, the conviction of things not seen.
