Nursery: Care is available for infants up to age 5 during worship at 9 AM worship, and to age 3 at 10:45 AM.



Mayfair-Plymouth Church is Moving! On Friday, June 19, we purchased the former Cub Foods building at 5055 Jackman Road in Toledo. I cannot tell you the great joy it was sitting at the closing.
