Tell Someone "The Story"

Recently I was leading a bible study at Haveloch Commons and we were getting a preview into Advent with the account of Mary and Joseph fleeing to Egypt. This happened after the birth of Jesus so that they might escape the wrath of King Herod. Herod set out to kill the young Savior by murdering all of the children in the town of Bethlehem. What horrible days those must have been living under the senseless wrath of a king who had no concern for his people other than how they could bring him personal glory and power. We learned much about the character of Joseph as he received instruction from God and in a great measure of faith uprooted his new family and took them to Egypt. In our conversation we thought about how that year in Egypt must have strengthened Mary and Jo-

seph as a couple and as a family. After they returned to their homeland from a year in a foreign country they surely had a sense of empowerment and renewed strength to face their hometown with a reality that few if any would believe or understand. The hardships they faced in Bethlehem and in Egypt forged their character into a shape that would be used by God from that point into eternity. And each step of their journey was forordained by God himself and much of it was spoken of by the prophets hundreds of years earlier.

Our Bible is full of fascinating accounts just like this one. It was my challenge to the members of that Bible study and now also to each of you to tell the Story of Christ's birth this season. The story is not as well known as you might suspect and many of our children and grandchildren would love to hear it from our very own lips regardless of how many times they have heard the Scripture read. Take some time and study up on a part of the Christmas story and make time to tell it to someone you love. They will be blessed and so will you.





Congregational Meeting Sunday, January 24, 2010

CONGREGATIONAL MEETING

On Sunday January 24th we will be holding our annual Congregational Meeting immediately following the 10:45 a.m. service of worship. There will be four items of business on the agenda, (1) the approval of the Pastor's Terms of Call, (2) the election of officers, (3) the review of the congregation's annual report, and (4) updating of our church by-laws.

Session has decided to condense our congregational meeting format to include just one meeting each year. In the past we have had two separate meetings, one for the nomination and election of officers and one for the review of the annual report and pastor Terms of Call. It is acceptable in the Presbyterian Church (USA) and common among Presbyterian Churches to only have one meeting. To officially make the change our congregational By-Laws will be amended by a vote of the congregation at the January meeting. In the new format, officers will be installed each year in the service of worship on the last Sunday in January and their terms will begin on February 1st of each year.
