4. What is the opposite of your current negativity, and how will you allow the Holy Spirit to transform you in these areas?
5. In your home church, Merge and crew what is the present ruling atmosphere?
6. What is the next step your spiritual community needs to take (in alignment with the Holy Spirit)?
7. What, by your attitude, faith and vision, can you do to enable that step to be taken?
