Mark Starner representing the Memorial and Bequest committee proposed the following changed to the By-laws for the committee.

Section 3.6 – release of interest.

No disbursement of earnings of Messiah Memorial, Bequest and Endowment Funds shall be made except by written request from Messiah Lutheran Church Council and upon approval by majority vote of the Board of Directors at a duly constituted meeting of the Board. Upon receipt of a written request from the Church Council, and upon approval of the Board of Directors, these funds will be disbursed by the Treasurer of the Messiah Memorial, Bequest and Endowment Funds in accordance with instructions of the Church Council.

Asked to have the written authorization from Council removed. Council did not want to remove this section, but will be diligent about authorizing the release of the interest on an annual basis so the funds may be used.

Section 3.9 – annual audit

<u>AUDITS</u>. The financial records of Messiah Memorial, Bequest and Endowment Funds shall be subject to an annual **audit by the** regular audit committee of Messiah Lutheran Church.

Motion by Shirley seconded by Jim to change audit to a financial review by a committee of two people appointed by the council. The financial review will coincide with the church fiscal year. Motion carried

Section 1.4 – selection of Directors

<u>DIRECTORS.</u> Directors shall be **nominated** and **elected** by the annual meeting of Messiah Lutheran Church Congregation by majority vote thereof. Election to the Board of Directors (exclusive of the representative of the church council) shall be for a term of three (3) years. The Board of Directors shall consist of seven members. Members whose terms expire shall be **elected or re-elected** at each annual meeting of Messiah Lutheran Congregation. Directors may be re-elected for successive terms and serve a maximum of two (2) consecutive terms

Motion by Jim seconded by Faye to change the words nominated and elected to appointed and affirmed. M/C

We will also be looking for assistance in assembling them when they are run in December. Look for the booklets in early January

Thank you for supporting our recent Pie and Bake sale. Your donation of baked goods and time to make the apple pies was greatly appreciated. A special "Thank You" to all those who donated apples. We had so many apples we were able to make 67 pies this year. We made \$983.00 which also included the dollars earned at the pie and ice cream event at the Holiday Expo. This money will help support our monthly mission projects as well as items for the Mission Kits and quilting. We will be looking into applying for Thrivent Funds for helping to fund our Mission Kits.

Here is a tally of our Mission Kits for 2016: 35 School Kits, 21 Newborn Kits, 6 Baby Care Kits, 10 Personal Care Kits, and 9 Hospice kits. 50 quilts were made plus 25 baby quilts. 20 purses were filled with personal items for Women in Crisis through Someplace Safe.

We are planning to assemble baskets on Thursday, December 15th at 1:00 PM. Our understanding is we are not allowed to bring homemade items for distribution to the nursing homes so we will do fruit baskets or small Christmas gifts for the nursing homes and distribute the homemade items to the homebound members. If you would bring your contribution to the church sometime during the week of December 11th it would be greatly appreciated. We also need volunteers to assemble and deliver the baskets. Please notify us if you are able to help.
