Dear Friends in Christ,

When I came to Messiah six years ago one of the goals discussed was that I would help lead a Succession Planning Process to help call the next pastor. This goal/plan is so that there can hopefully be a seamless transition as I retire and the new pastor begins their ministry.

With this Succession Plan there is no interim pastor and interim period; no time where the church spins in limbo; no major loss in momentum. Rather it is me passing the baton to the next pastor so the ministry keeps moving ahead in positive ways.

This also means that my exact retirement date from Messiah is not set in stone. My hope is to continue my ministry at Messiah until this transition happens—even if it is the first couple weeks of June. My prayer is that this succession process we have been working toward these past six years will bring a new pastor to Messiah by late May or early June.

Therefore Messiah's Succession Planning Team (Call Committee) is meeting regularly now to help enable this process. The challenge right now throughout the ELCA is to get names and candidates. There are fewer pastors overall today with very few new pastors graduating from seminary. There are also fewer pastors today looking to move to rural towns and churches.

Where the Northwestern Minnesota Synod (ELCA) used to give congregations a list of possible candidates, they now encourage congregations to network and find their own recommendations. The Synod may still pass on some names if they know of someone—yet they encourage us to get the word out to family and friends who may recommend an excellent possibility.

In the past couple months I have reached out to more than 20 pastors I know asking them to network and pass on any recommendations they may have. I encourage you at Messiah to do the same. One congregation I know of found their pastor through a Facebook post one of their members posted with some friends from North Dakota. Don't ever underestimate your power to network and publicize Messiah's call.

Messiah did receive one candidate's name and profile in early January (name needs to remain confidential with the Call Committee at this point in the process). The Succession Planning Team is seeking more information from this person before they decide if they move ahead with an interview, etc. It takes some very careful evaluation to decide whether a candidate is the right match for Messiah's ministry.

Messiah's Succession Planning Team would also like several other names and candidates so they can better weigh the strengths of each person. It is always helpful to evaluate two or three candidates as a congregation attempts to call an excellent leader for their church.

Please remember this Succession Planning Process in your prayers; pray that God's Holy Spirit will lead the right pastor to come to Messiah. Also please pray for the Holy Spirit to show you ways you can network and possibly lead our congregation to some other possible candidates. May God's amazing and miraculous power surround this whole transitional process.


Impact-


