MESSIAH PIANO OFFER

On a recommendation from the Property Team – the Messiah Council has decided to dispose of two pianos in the church that are never used. It was the feeling that these two pianos should be offered first to members of Messiah and then if there was no interest; open the offer to the public by advertising.

<u>Piano #1</u> – This is an Everett piano and is light blond in color and does not have a bench. It is located in the fellowship hall next to the door leading to the kitchen. According to our piano tuner, this piano is in fair shape and is tunable.

This piano will be offered to Messiah members on a bid basis. If you are interested in this piano, simply place your bid in a sealed envelope marked "Piano Bid" and give it to Becky Meyer at the church office. Bids will be accepted until Sunday, June 18th and will be opened on Monday, June 19th. The new owner will be responsible for removing the piano from the church property.

<u>Piano #2</u> – This is a Janssen piano and is tan in color with a bench. It is located in the northeast Sunday School room next to the door. The piano tuner said this piano is not very tunable. There are several keys that are out of tune. Therefore, we will give this piano away. If you have an interest in this piano, place your name in a sealed envelope marked "Free Piano" and give it to Becky Meyer at the church office. Bids will be accepted until Sunday, June 18th and will be opened on Monday, June 19th. Since this piano is going to be given away, there may be several bids. If that is the case, a drawing will take place for this piano. Again, with this piano, it will be the new owner's responsibility to remove it from the church.
