We donated several quilts to Someplace Safe in Alexandria along with ones we donated to those in need. Thank you to everyone who donated fabric and jeans for quilt making. Thank you to the women quilters who gave so much of their time to making the quilts. It really is a fun fellowship time. Come and join us. You don't need any previous experience to tie a knot!

The "Mission of the Month" for May is items for newborn kits. The items that are needed are: 1 regular size bath towel (thinner type) new or gently used and no longer than 48 inches, 1 washcloth, 1 bath size bar of Ivory soap, 1 newborn (small) stocking cap (keep hand knit ones very small), 1 baby cotton blend or flannel shirt/kimono size 0-3 (short sleeves), 2 cloth diapers, 2 diaper pins, 1 receiving blanket (approximately 30" by 30"). Pack items in a 2 gallon zip lock bag, squeeze air out of bag. You can drop them off in the basket provided in the Narthex. Items for any of the mission kits may be dropped off any time. Kit items are listed in you WELCA book. Please mark what kit you are donating to when you drop them off. We can also use used bath and hand towels for our AIDS/Hospice kits and midwife kits.


