#### WELCA Minutes - Thursday, September 15, 2016

Arlou Swenson opened the meeting with a prayer.

**Financial Report** – WELCA has a balance of \$17,744.92. This amount reflects the money put aside in savings for future designated areas. General Income through August was \$7,293.42. Expenditures for 2016 through August was \$5,173.15.

#### **Business:**

There is a Conference 8 (originally referred to as Cluster 10) Fall Gathering on Saturday, October 8<sup>th</sup> at First Lutheran Church in Alexandria. Registration and coffee will begin at 8:30 with a 9:30 business meeting followed by a 10:30 program and a 12 noon luncheon. Cost is \$10 per person. Sylvia made the motion that WELCA be willing to pay for anyone interested in going. Shirley Sampson seconded it. Motion approved. You need to register by October 3<sup>rd</sup>. Contact Arlou or Becky if you are planning to go. We will send a \$50 offering from our WELCA group along with the \$25 assessment fee.

We do not know yet when we will be shipping boxes to Lutheran World Relief or Global Missions but you will be notified to come and help pack boxes prior to that date. We will confirm that we will need \$35 to cover shipping fees from Osakis.

We will need many people, men and women, to participate in this pie making event. We will plan to store them in Marlene Nelson's walk-in freezer until it is time to sell them. We will plan to sell them at the Youth Turkey dinner on November 13<sup>th</sup>. If we have leftovers we could also sell some at the Holiday Expo on November 19<sup>th</sup>. Cindy Kloos suggested we try to sell at both events.

Arlou brought 20 quilts to the Salvation Army in Fergus Falls. They were very receptive to them as they said there are more homeless families in their area than ever before. It was questioned if there wasn't a representative for Grant County to deliver quilts to. We will try to see if there is a local representative in the future. There is a Salvation Army in Morris but that would be for the Stevens County area.

We talked about how life is so much easier now that we have Darrel's to provide the food for funerals. Now that he is the only resource for us Arlou suggested if he would be short of help we could help make the sandwiches if need be. A big thank you to everyone who stepped up to help at the Pat Anderson funeral.

Cindy Kloos stated it would be nice to have a list of people willing to babysit for families in the community if they need to go shopping, especially during the holidays.

The women brought and filled purses with personal items for women to be distributed at Some Place Safe. Thanks to Marlys Rollofson for obtaining a credit card from Thrivent to purchase items for these purses. We have many purses left and will do this again at a later date.

The next General meeting will be Thursday, November 10<sup>th</sup> to discuss the 2017 calendar and look at groups and leaders.

Arlou said the Triannual Gathering is scheduled for Minneapolis on July 13-16, 2017. More information will follow at a later date.
