# May We Run As Others Have

Frances Jane "Fanny" Crosby was an American hymn writer and poetess who wrote over 8,000 hymns during the late 1800's and early 1900's. She lost her sight when she was six weeks old through the negligence of an attending physician. At the age of nine she wrote:

"Oh what a happy soul I am,  
Although I cannot see;  
I am resolved that in this world  
Contented I will be.  
How many blessings I enjoy,  
That other people don't;  
To weep and sigh because I'm blind,  
I cannot, and I won't."

Once a preacher sympathetically remarked, "I think it is a great pity that the Master did not give you sight when He showered so many other gifts upon you." She replied quickly, "Do you know that if at birth I had been able to make one petition, it would have been that I should be born blind?" "Why?" asked the surprised minister. "Because when I get to heaven, the first face that shall ever gladden my sight will be that of my Savior!"

I personally love to hear the stories of those who have gone before us and have exercised great faith. These stories challenge me. Convict me. Encourage me. And, these stories drive a stake of assurance right in the middle of my chest. I see people all the time in the halls of our church that have a deep abiding faith in the sovereign God of the universe. When I see this type of faith, I am compelled deeper in my faith!

The writer of Hebrews exhorts us to remember and embrace those who have gone before us - "Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight, and sin which clings so closely, and let us run with endurance the race that is set before us."

Let us consider the "great cloud of witnesses"(Hebrews 12:1) that has gone before us. Let's run the race of faith. A runner is encouraged to run a race by looking forward at all times. This is wonderful for the Christian because the very next line in Hebrews 12 concludes that we should fix our gaze on Jesus. Jesus is the greatest thing about the race set before us; Jesus is the finish line! Like Fanny Crosby, when we get to heaven, the first face that shall gladden our sight will be that of our Savior!
