Goodbye Celebration for Rev. Jared Parker and Family

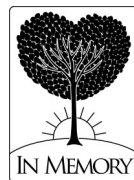

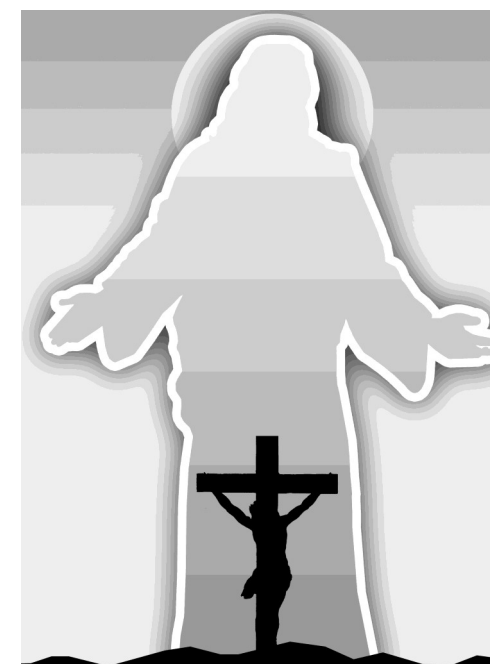
