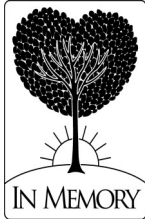


Welcome To Our Church

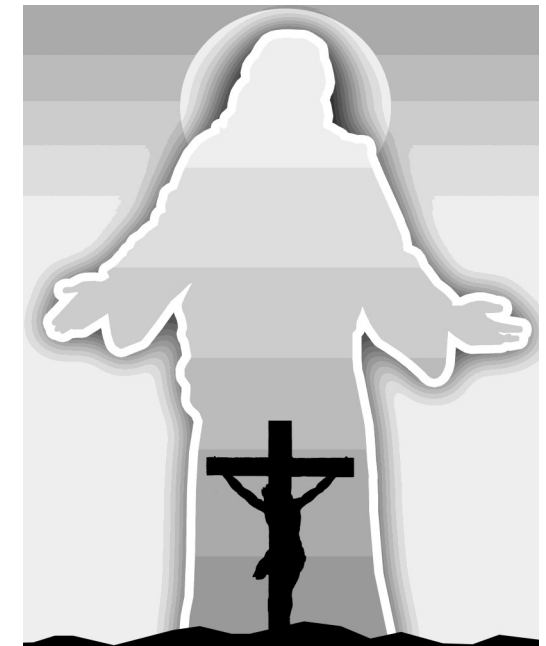
