Drop OFF/ Pick UP

Parents will drop off and pick up students at CAMP. We will be in the Parker Lodge. Take the first left after entering camp (by the chapel). The lodge is the 4th building on the right. You will be in the back of the building. You may enter thru the dorm rooms.

ALL Campers: Drop off 3 pm, Sunday, July 8th

Part-Time Campers: Pick up 6 pm, Wednesday, July 11th

Full-Time Campers: Pick up 11am, Saturday, July 14th

Medication:

Please put ALL medication in a ziploc bag with detailed instructions. Medication will be taken up as students are dropped off and distributed as needed while at camp.

Money:

There is a camp store that students can visit daily, after "down time". They sell candy, slushies, and sodas. They also sell souvenirs, like water bottles, t-shirts, bags, etc. \$10 is usually enough. Your child will have an account for the week. You can give this to your child at drop off.

Snacks:

We will provide snacks. The only food your child needs to bring is requested on the packing list. Please DO NOT send ANY other food. It becomes very messy in the dorm rooms!!
