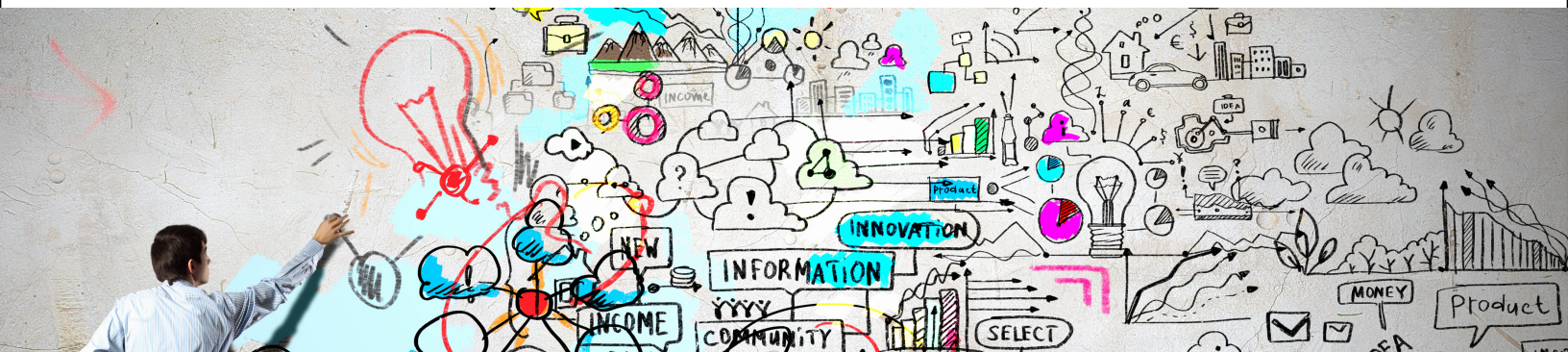


DON'T JUST STAND THERE— START SOMETHING!
