

T.R.I.P. (SHOPWITHSCRIP) INFORMATION AND POLICIES
Tuition Reduction Incentive Program

All participants must have an online account established to participate in the T.R.I.P. program. We encourage everyone to place their regular T.R.I.P. orders online after setting up their online account, however, paper orders can still be accepted. You can also order online but still pay with a check or Presto Pay. If ordering Regular T.R.I.P. online and paying with a check, checks must be received no later than 9:00 a.m. on processing day. Instant T.R.I.P. orders will still be a paper order on Instant T.R.I.P. days, but you must have an online account established in order to place an order. Please see the following sheets to sign up or call/visit the MCS office (616-877-4688) for help in signing up.

Moline Christian School is involved in a funding program called T.R.I.P. (Tuition Reduction Incentive Program) to help each family reduce their tuition. With this program, every time you order certificates through Moline Christian from participating stores, your savings is accumulated. That amount is then deducted from your tuition, or accumulated if you are a future family. Percentages vary anywhere from 1.5% to 49%!

Even if your child is not old enough to be enrolled yet, you can still start accumulating toward your tuition costs. Friends, relatives, and neighbors can also participate and have earnings designated to your account. Please remember that if you have relatives, neighbors, etc. helping you with this program, it is your responsibility to keep them updated on all T.R.I.P. information regarding this program.

1. You may order as many certificates as you would like in denominations of \$5, \$10, \$20, etc. This is just exchanging dollars for certificates, same as cash; \$10 = \$10 worth of certificates.
2. Anyone with overdraft charges, whether from paper checks and/or a Presto Pay account, will incur a \$50 fee to be paid to T.R.I.P. After two insufficient checks are made on a T.R.I.P. account, you will be put on a money order basis only. Please remember that for security reasons, only personal checks or money orders are accepted. For Instant T.R.I.P., cash can be accepted, but not Regular T.R.I.P.
3. During the school year, Regular T.R.I.P. orders are placed on most Monday mornings and will be ready by Wednesday afternoon or Thursday. Instant T.R.I.P. orders are on designated Friday mornings. With Instant T.R.I.P., approximately 50 of our top selling merchants are available for purchase instantly instead of waiting 2-3 days for your order as with Regular T.R.I.P. In the summer, Regular T.R.I.P. and Instant T.R.I.P. are processed on designated Tuesdays. (See schedule for processing dates established.)
4. Check online at shopwithscrip.com for any bonuses in effect. Paper order forms of many items are available in the rack by the MCS office.
5. Current families will have their accumulated earnings applied to their tuition account on a quarterly basis, which will be the end of: September, December, March, and the beginning of July. If you have chosen to have your earnings sent to another Christian school, this will also be on a quarterly basis. With shopwithscrip.com, you can check your earnings balance at any time. Future family earnings will accumulate until they become a parent at Moline Christian School.
6. K-8 parents may choose to send and receive T.R.I.P. certificates through their children by filling out the correct area when you sign up online through shopwithscrip.com. Please follow directions after signing up and also look at the "announcements" area online.
7. If any credit (overpayment) is accumulated on your tuition account, it can only be used toward the following year's tuition or another fund through Moline Christian as designated. NO CASH CREDITS GIVEN. In other words, if you create a credit on your tuition account either by overpaying through tuition payments or because of T.R.I.P. earnings, it is ILLEGAL to refund you any amount of money that would have been considered T.R.I.P. earnings on your account.
8. Stores will not give cash refunds for certificates.
9. If you are a current tuition paying family at MCS and your status changes to a non-paying family, i.e., your youngest child has graduated from Moline Christian School, and you wish to continue participation in the T.R.I.P. program, please make sure you e-mail school to designate the appropriate area/school for your earnings. Many families continue to participate after their children have graduated and send earnings to a Christian high school or Christian college. Please make sure you also fill out a Relative/Friend/Future Family Form if you are a participant in Meijer Community Rewards or Harding's Escrip (see below). This is also required if we are sending your earnings to another Christian school and your status at that school changes. Failure to do this will result in future earnings being directed toward the MCS Tuition Assistance Fund.
10. Other programs:
 - a. Meijer Community Rewards Program – Sign up at Meijer for their Community Rewards program or go to www.meijer.com/rewards to sign up. The MCS account number is **102634**. Earnings are 1% if you pay with a Meijer credit card, .5% if you pay with cash or a debit card. Meijer, Inc. does not pay any earnings if you pay with another company's credit card. Earnings are applied to participant accounts as Meijer sends checks.
 - b. Harding's Markets – Go to Harding's and pick up their Escrip card, call the "800" number to activate your card by giving them our school code (**34274**), your Escrip card number, and any other information they might need such as your name, address, etc. Earnings are based on monthly purchases. See their information sheet for specifics. Earnings are applied to participant accounts as Escrip sends money to school.
 - c. If you have friends/family/relatives participating in either of the above two programs, or if you are not a current tuition paying family at Moline Christian School, you/they must fill out a Friend/Family/Relative Form, located in the rack by the MCS office. Failure to do this results in earnings being directed to the MCS Tuition Assistance Fund. While Meijer Community Rewards and Harding's Escrip are listed on T.R.I.P. information as a way for you to earn extra money toward tuition, they are NOT part of the T.R.I.P. program.
