**WELCOME:** What are you most afraid of?

WORD: Read Isaiah 53:2-3

What part of the sermon and scripture really stuck out to you, and why?

Every good and perfect gift comes from God - but we can miss it completely! Even Isaiah (53:3) foretold of God's greatest gift, the coming of the Messiah, and still most would miss it! Why would God give a gift such as this in an understated way? How was God working in your life before you recognized it? When we are given a promise by God, what can we do to be sure we don't miss it?

Describe a time when you heard a word from the Lord and the opposite happened. Was your initial response to shrink back or persevere?

Share some examples of grace-filled returns in your life, as you've aligned your actions and investments toward the eternal kingdom of God.

Though we have a *personal* relationship with Jesus Christ, we are called to work collectively as a church. What is the Holy Spirit saying to you about your place here at Monterey Church? How are you responding?

- 5. Consistently commit to investing in lives outside the church and inviting them in. (Matthew 9:35-38)
- 6. Consistent and committed participation on a Serve Team. (Mark 10:45)
