WELCOME: What is the origin of your name?

WORSHIP: Worship Playlist

WORD: Song of Songs 3:1-11

The first poem in this scripture (v. 1-5) reflects a deep sense of passionate urgency.

What relationships, or opportunities, do we tend to take for granted, and why?

How does your relationship with Jesus present a sense of passionate urgency (ex. pursuit, union, romance, action, joy, etc.) through:

- 1. The relationship with your spouse?
- 2. Your circle of influence?
- 3. Being on mission for Him?

This is applicable to each of you!

- 1. Describe different ways that an actively healthy MARRIAGE has temporal AND eternal implications. (Ex. How does a healthy marriage affect our ability to minister and evangelize to the neighbors around us?)
- 2. Describe different ways that actively healthy RELATIONSHIPS within the body of Christ have temporal AND eternal implications. (Ex. How does a healthy unity within the body of Christ affect our ability to minister and evangelize to the neighbors around us?)

The second poem (v. 6-11) focuses on the wedding scene. What is the applicable illustration of King Solomon (the groom) and how is this symbolic to Christ and the church (the bride)? (The romanticism behind the wedding. A big ordeal, spared no expense, his eyes are fixed on his love...)

Focusing on the symbolic overture of a healthy and unified marriage between man, woman, and God - How does this scripture ultimately reflect the passionate Gospel of Jesus Christ for you?

WITNESS: As we live with a sense of passionate urgency focused on Christ and his mission, what active/applicable ways can we live out the gospel of Christ with those in our circle of influence this week?
