WORD: Read Acts 8:1-8

- What part of the sermon, or scripture, resonated most with you this week?
- What happened to the church in this passage? Why do you think God allowed the persecution of the Jerusalem church?
- What does 'persecution' for our faith in Jesus Christ look like to you?
- What do we see, in this scene, as the fruit of living a radical lifestyle, surrendered and in fluid obedience to Christ and the Holy Spirit?
- What are some very specific ways that you can be living that radical lifestyle?
- How might living a radical lifestyle be the key to experiencing breakthroughs in your life?

Read Psalm 84:1-2 & 5-7

- As hearts are set on making their pilgrimage, what do we see God doing?
- In this season of your life, what does 'pilgrimage' look like? How do you see The Lord working on your behalf?
- What did you learn through this portion of scripture that might help/encourage you to overcome some trials/hurdles in life?
- What are some promises from scripture that you can cling to as you set your heart on pilgrimage even when facing opposition (ex. Dt. 31:6)?
