WELCOME: If you could travel to any time period for one day, what period would it be, and why?

WORD: Read Acts 8:28-40

- What part of the sermon, or scripture, resonated most with you this week?
- What are the characteristics of the Ethiopian eunuch? Are they important? Why?
- Phillip and the Ethiopian eunuch's encounter was not a random moment in time; but an orchestrated, divine appointment from the Lord. Why do you think the Lord orchestrated these events?
- How about you? God has set things in motion for you to be right here, hearing the good news of Jesus. Describe why/how God orchestrated your saving encounter with Christ.
- What is our response after encountering the good news of Jesus through a divine appointment?
- How can thinking we can atone for our sins apart from Christ block us from receiving His saving grace?
- When we think of how the good news is received, what role does God's advanced preparation have? How about a seeker's personal initiative? Or, what about how we are used by God to meet a seeker where he/she is at?

WITNESS: Filled with the Holy Spirit, who will you proclaim your faith to this week? Who needs to experience the great joy and peace like the eunuch? What person, in your circle of influence, is absolutely ready to experience a divine appointment from the Lord? Lift them up in prayer this week.
