WORD: Read Acts 9:1-19

- What part of the sermon, or scripture, resonated most with you this week?
- Paul was so sure that persecuting Christians was the right thing to do, only to be turned around by Jesus. Describe an experience in your life when you knew you were absolutely ‘right’.
 1. What were you ‘right’ about? What was driving you?
 2. How did you act? What were your emotions?
 3. How did others react to you?
- Now, talk about the moment you suddenly realized you were wrong.
 1. What happened?
 2. How did you feel?
 3. What was your reaction?
- God’s desire for his children is to be acting in accordance to His will, not ours. How has God intervened and completely reversed the direction of your life?
- Following Ananias’ obedience to the Lord, Saul was suddenly filled with the Holy Spirit, and “something like scales” fell off of his eyes. In response to the obedient calling of Christ, how has He led you into uncertain and scary situations, only to protect and bless you, and others, in these circumstances?

WITNESS: Is the Holy Spirit leading you into a loving, yet uncertain and scary conversation this week? How might each of you see God work, as you walk in obedience to His call?
