



Wilderness North Prayer Retreat

January 18th-21st, 2018

If you would like some quiet time with God, then join us as we travel to Brimson, MN, just a few miles west of Two Harbors. There you will find your rustic cabin awaiting you in the midst of a northeastern Minnesota wilderness.

Two meals per day are cooked with love and served with kindness to us by Eric and Lynn, the caretakers of Wilderness North. We visit one another for meals (or you can have a cheese and cracker basket brought to you at your cabin if you prefer to be alone)—take hikes, snowshoe or ski either alone or with others, whatever you prefer—stoke the wood stove in our individual cabins—and spend time with God in prayer, His word and/or a book of your choosing.

The cost for 3 nights lodging and 6 meals (Thursday night dinner, 2 meals on Friday & Saturday and lunch on Sunday) is about \$200 for one person. The cost only increases slightly for couples, as you pay \$8 per meal. The lodging price is the same for single or couples.

The team will leave Thursday morning at 9 am from the church and return Sunday afternoon around 3pm.

A \$50 deposit is needed by November 19th to secure the January weekend dates for us.
