

E-Reader Acceptable Use Policy

Secondary school students (7th-12th Grades) are allowed to use electronic readers (e-readers) at school (i.e. Kindles, Nooks, iPads, etc.; not cell and smart phones). While we are excited that students are using new technology to nurture their love of reading, we do have some rules for the appropriate use of these devices.

Rules for using e-readers

- 1. All e-readers must be labeled with the student's first and last name.
- 2. Each student is responsible for his/her own e-reader and is not allowed to lend it to another student while at school.
- 3. E-readers can be used in class only when the teacher gives the student permission.
- 4. E-readers are to be used for reading only and only for books that have been pre- approved.
- 5. E-readers may not be used at school for audio books.
- 6. All e-readers must have cellular and network capabilities disabled (turned off) while the device is at school otherwise the device will be taken away only to be retrieved by a parent. This means that books must be downloaded prior to coming to school.
- 7. The e-reader must be charged prior to bring it to school. Students will not be allowed to charge their e-reader at school.
- 8. The e-reader must not be a distraction for the student or those around him/her nor be a source of any classroom disruption.
- 9. The student is responsible for knowing how to properly and effectively use their e-reader; students may not ask teachers to assist with the use of the device.
- 10. The privilege to use an e-reader can be revoked at any time.
