## Call for MVA WASC Committee Members

Periodically Mountain View Academy reviews our overall school program as part of our WASC (Western Association of Schools and Colleges) accreditation. As part of this review four focus groups are formed to study four distinct areas of the school program. **Organization for Student Learning** reviews the organization structure of the school. The **Curriculum, Instruction, and Assessment** looks at what we teach, how we teach, and how we know the students are learning. **Support for Student Personal, Academic, and Spiritual Growth** examines how we are meeting the needs of the students. Finally, **Resource Management and Development** studies how well we use the financial and other resources we have including how well we are preparing for the future of the school. Various staff and school board members have selected committees to be a part of. However, the committees are not complete without parental involvement.

While we have used parent surveys to gather some information, it is also critical that parents volunteer for committee service. **If you would like to be a part of the WASC self-study evaluation process, please contact Mrs. Camba in the office.** We will need your name, 1st and 2nd choice of committee, email address, and the best way to contact you. We will then provide additional information to you including a schedule of meeting times. Because this is a study process, the initial meetings are very important to provide information about the school while later meetings help develop plans for the future.

We hope that a good representation of parents will be available to be a part of this evaluation process.
