In the MCCA Kindergarten programs, your child can be trained "in the way he should go" so that "when he is old he will not depart from it" (Proverbs 22:6). Four Year Old Kindergarten

Upon the completion of our K4 program, students should be able to:

- ☺ Know colors
- ☺ Know shapes
- ☺ Know and recognize the alphabet in mixed order
- ☺ Know the sounds of each letter
- ☺ Print letters A-Z in upper and lower case
- ☺ Print their name
- ☺ Sound out and read blends
- ☺ Begin sounding out and reading three letter words
- ☺ Know special sounds including sight words (I, a, and the)
- ☺ Know and recognize numbers 1-10 and be familiar with numbers 11-20 in random order
- ☺ Count from 1 to 20 by themselves
- ☺ Count from 1 to 100 with some help
- ☺ Recognize that the number 9 goes with 9 objects
- ☺ Write their numbers from 1 to 20

preparation

Our Kindergarten programs use the time-tested *A Beka Book* curriculum. Each class has goals set to prepare our students for the next grade. The four year old program prepares students for our challenging five year old class. The five year old class continues to enhance what was learned the previous year and prepares students for the first grade.

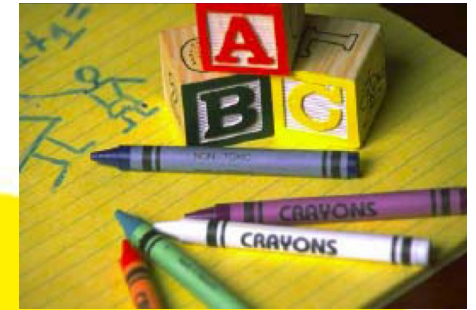
Five Year Old Kindergarten

A student ready to enter the first grade will have been taught in K5 to:

- ☺ Know the name and sound of all five vowels
- ☺ Know the name and sound of all consonants
- ☺ Be able to put a consonant and vowel together as a blend
- ☺ Be able to distinguish a vowel or consonant sound within a short word
- ☺ Be able to locate any number 1-50
- ☺ Be able to write any number 1-50
- ☺ Be able to count to 100 by 1's, 5's, and 10's
- ☺ Be able to add 1 and 0 to numbers less than 10
- ☺ Be able to write before and after numbers by 1's
- ☺ Be able to read time to the hour and half hour
- ☺ Know and recognize the value of a penny, nickel, and dime
- ☺ Be able to count groups of coins of the same value
- ☺ Be able to find the greatest and least number out of a group of three numbers
