King Street UB Church "Raise the Roof" fundraising campaign:

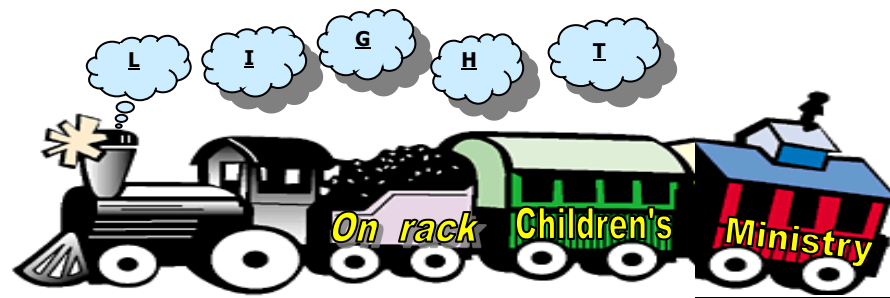

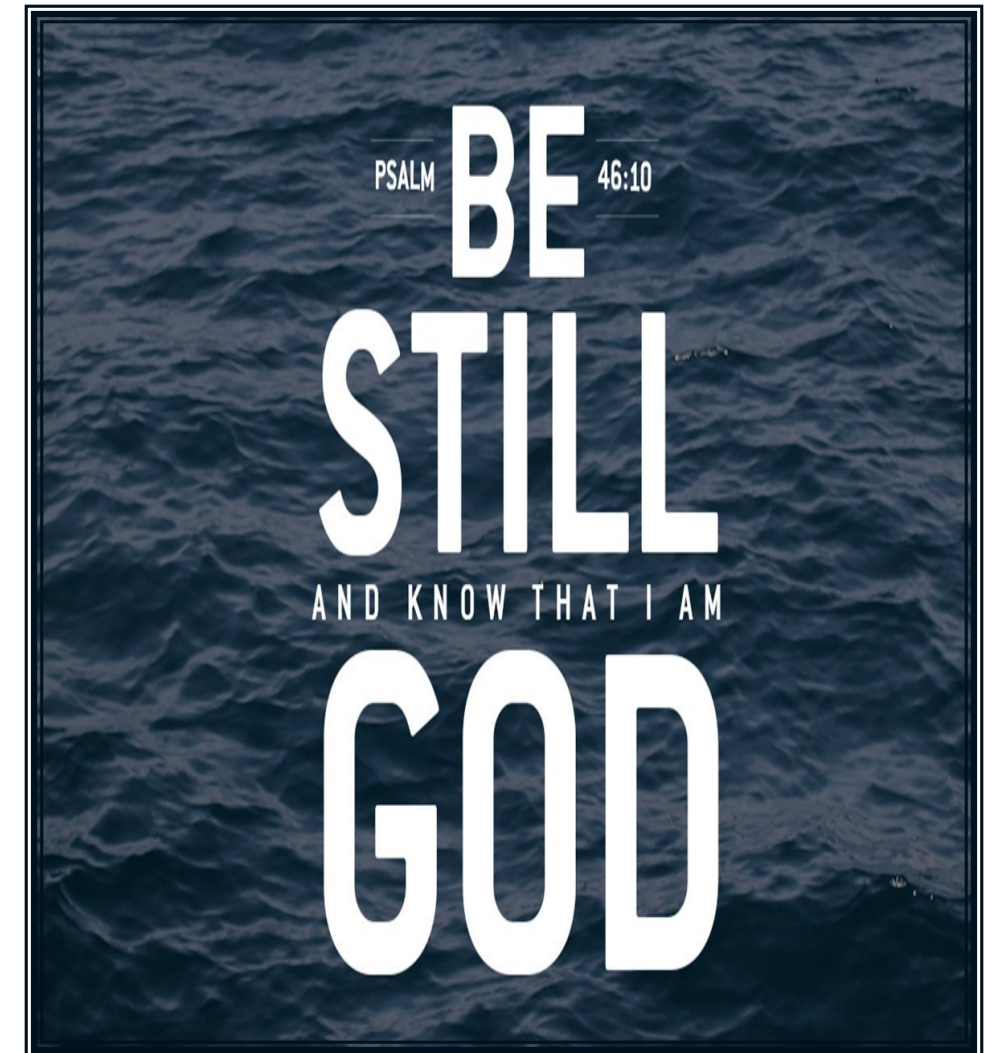
